In each semester, the applicant is expected to teach two undergraduate courses at freshman and sophomore levels (each consisting of fifteen 90-minites classes) offered by the Institute for Liberal Arts and Sciences, Kyoto University. The freshman courses are titled as "Introduction to Economics," and "Principles of Economics," and the sophomore courses are "Economy and Society 1" and "Economy and Society 2." He/she is also expected to teach a fifteen 90-minites graduate course in each semester offered by the graduate school of economics and to supervise graduate students' theses (both MA and Ph.D.) All instructions are expected to be carried out in English.

The standards for selection for this position include: (1) strong research achievements at an international standard, (2) capability to engage in research activities relevant to our permanent research sections, and (3) readiness to engage in joint research activities.
